Dear Arcare Melbourne Communities,

The recent spike of COVID-19 cases across Victoria means that our current restrictions on visitation remain in place for the foreseeable future.

In addition, the same restrictions for leaving the Residence are in place for residents as for the broader community. This includes:

- Shopping for necessary goods and services
- Caregiving or compassionate reasons, including medical care or to get a COVID-19 test
- Authorised work or permitted education
- Exercise (once a day for 2 hours)
- To get a COVID-19 vaccine.

The **5km limit and face masks** orders are also in force. Residents who are leaving are required to fill out the Social Leave form beforehand. Leaving our Residences does bring risk and we ask all residents and families to consider this before planning an outing to consider if it is essential as per the above list.

Single site working remains in place for our team members, and we continue to assist our team members to conveniently access the COVID-19 vaccine ahead of the mandatory deadline of 17 September 2021.

It is a timely reminder to please get tested for COVID-19 the moment you experience any symptoms, regardless of how mild, and to access the COVID-19 vaccine if can.

We understand that is a difficult time for our residents and families and are on hand to provide support as best we can. If you have any questions, requests or concerns, please reach out to your Residence Manager.
